# RISING STAR STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Oceantic Network's Rising Star Student Scholarship is awarded each year to college-bound high school seniors who have demonstrated impeccable academic achievement and a keen interest in pursuing a career in offshore renewable energy and other complimentary ocean renewables. Each scholarship award will be for a total of \$5,000, which must be used toward tuition fees.

#### **ELIGIBILITY & CRITERIA**

- A high school student currently in their senior year (class of 2024) intending to enroll full time in a two or four-year college or university beginning fall 2024
- Demonstrates excellent academic achievement and community service
- Involvement in school projects related to any aspect of offshore wind or other ocean renewables, and/or an internship working with companies involved the industry
- Applicants will be judged by academic industry leaders and Network Board members based on their interest in pursuing a career in offshore wind and other ocean renewables, academic, academic achievement, and financial need

All applicants will be judged solely on their submitted materials. Up to two letters of recommendations will be allowed.
